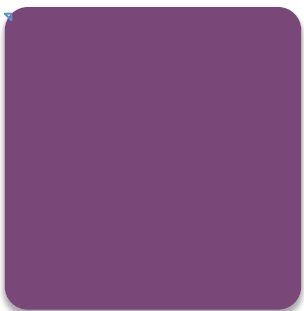
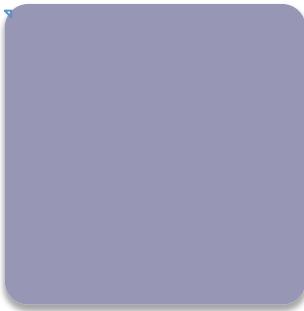

STEM Problem Solving Days

A range of activities is available to suit all age groups and ability levels. These are ideal mechanisms for bringing young people together in a non threatening environment.

Extended Project Work

Sentinus has considerable experience of bringing young people together to carry out STEM inquiry based learning projects, with curriculum relevant themes. These projects offer opportunities for students to meet and work together, as well as collaborating virtually. Projects can last from two weeks to ten weeks, and very often conclude with a celebration event, held either in school or at a neutral venue.
